White Nights in St. Petersburg

“White Nights in St. Petersburg” is one of our most popular trips to the former tsarist metropolis.

The tour begins in Malbork, continues into the Kaliningrad area over the Curonian Spit and through the three Baltic capitals, which you will get to know better during the city tours. The highlight of this trip is St. Petersburg with a four-day stay. Here you will not only see the Hermitage and the impressive Isaac’s Cathedral, but also visit the Peterhof Park and Pushkin with the Amber Room in Catherine’s Palace.

This route allows you to circumnavigate the Baltic Sea, including the areas of Russia less developed by camping tourism. From the Finnish border you can organize your own journey home. Alternatively, the Baltic States are also an interesting option for an interesting return journey.

Travel over the Curonian Spit to Lithuania

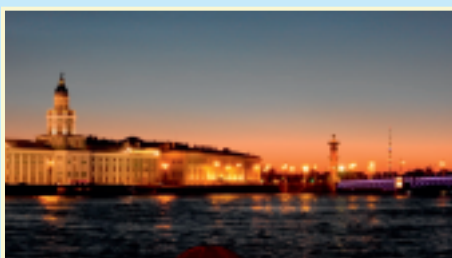
Day 5 Nida – Trakai 350km LT

Day 7 Trakai – Riga 360km LV

Bus, sightseeing hanseatic city

Day 9 Riga – Tallinn 330km EST
Reaching the capital of Estonia

Bus, sightseeing, historical old town

Day 11 Tallinn – Toila 190km EST
Place of nobility and sanatorium at the Sea

Day 12 Toila – St. Petersburg 230km RUS
Arrive at the former tsarist city

Day 13 St. Petersburg
Bus, sightseeing, Hermitage, “White Nights”

Day for individual exploring / day at leisure

Bus tour to Pushkin – Catherine’s palace
